This subcommittee last met on Monday, December 17, 2007 at 6 pm.

Members present: Mark B. – Chair ; Chad R., Benny and Will W., Chris M., and Jeff M.

### At this meeting we discussed the following:

1. **Placing a new literature order:** Over the last six months PI has successfully distributed nearly all of the IP's that were purchased in our last literature order. They went to supply literature holders in the lobbies of the various DCF, DJJ, County, State and Federal Probation Offices, Bridge Way, and Lakeview facilities operated in Crestview, Fort Walton Beach and Pensacola. Literature was also placed for distribution in the lobby of the Keaton facility in Pensacola and a literature holder was maintained by the nurse's station at the Twelve Oaks Drug and Alcohol Treatment Center in Navarre. Our request to Area was for \$500.00 so that we can procure the necessary IP's essential to maintain a six month supply.
